For 2010, Pony has improved the specification of three of the most popular models - the VBE and FVC finishing tables and the 405 shirt finisher.

VBE FINISHING TABLE

The **VBE** is one of Pony's most popular finishing tables. Now it has been comprehensively restyled to improve its performance and aesthetics. It is available in two different buck sizes, the standard at 1100mm and the Maxi at 1300mm. Both feature live and uniform steam distribution coupled with a strong vacuum. The VBE may be specified with integral boiler and vacuum (VB & VB Maxi) or without for connection to external services (VC & VC Maxi). It is offered with a wide selection of extras



including steam or steam/air spotting gun, swinging vacuum arm for sleeves, with or without lighting and a second set of operating pedals.

FVC FINISHING TABLE

The **FVC** is an entry level finishing table. It has an electrically heated buck with a powerful vacuum, a built-in boiler providing steam for the Junior/2 steam iron. The FVC is perfect for ironing shirts and so recommended for establishments looking to start an ironing service. It is available as the TA model with external connections for power and steam, the FVC with built in boiler and the new FVC-S model, which also has a blowing function.



MG405 SHIRT FINISHER

The improved mid range **MG405** model shirt finisher incorporates the latest technology and produces a perfect finish on any type of shirt material. Its features include a vacuum across the entire dummy area, which makes it easy for the operator to dress the shirt. The front closing paddle is flexible and padded, thereby eliminating pressure marks as well as avoiding gloss and scuffing to buttons and seams. The paddle is equipped with two joysticks so the operator can adjust the vertical alignment of the sleeve clamps to the armhole. A microprocessor with 10 programmes allows automatic steaming cycles to suit different fabric types and residual moisture content. New for 2010 are highly polished shoulder presses, which further improve the finish and increase the output to an impressive 40 shirts per hour.



The selection of the correct model of finishing table or press for an individual business depends very much on the type of trade a unit has, but with so many different models to choose from in the Pony range, one thing is certain, operators are sure to find one that meets their requirements and matches their budget. Start-up operations may not have
